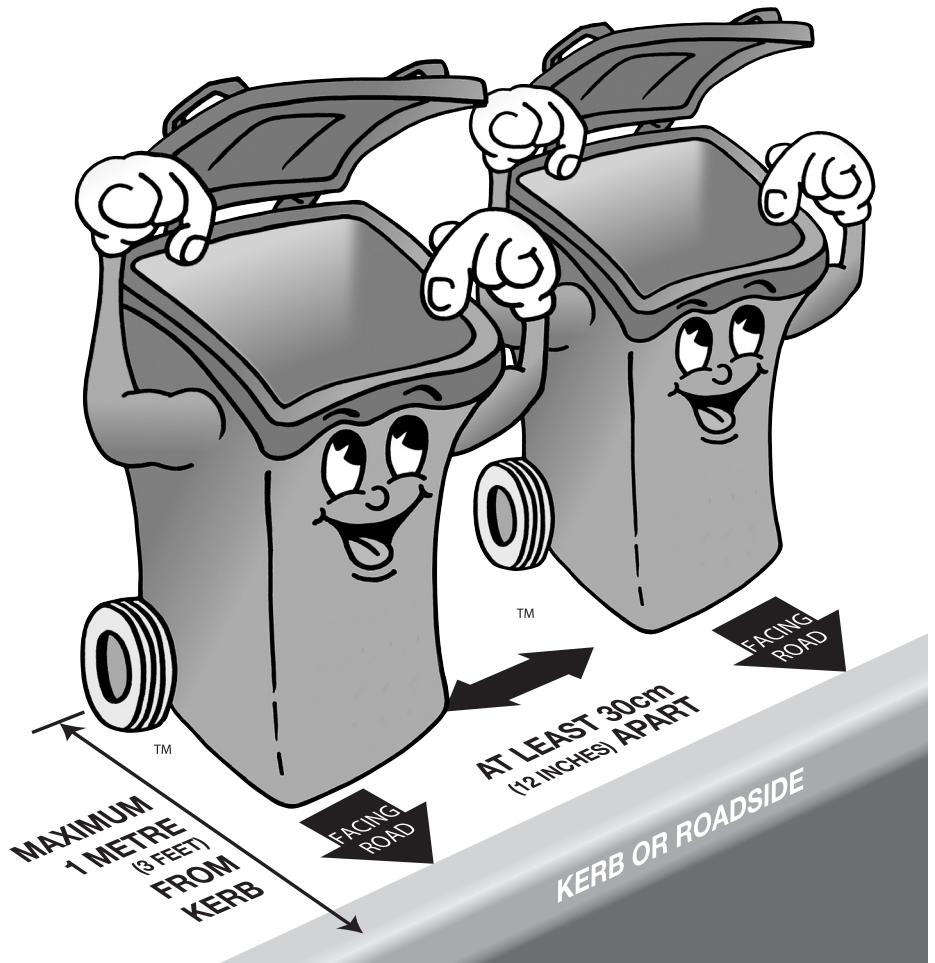


It's easy to get your bin emptied

Please...

- ✓ Place your bin out **by 6am on collection day**
- ✓ Place bin **on the kerb** – not on the road or footpath
- ✓ Place bins **30 centimetres apart** with bin handles facing the house so the lid opens to the road
- ✓ **Retrieve bin** as soon as possible after it's emptied
- ✓ **Bag all loose rubbish** including kitchen scraps, nappies, dust, lawn clippings and leaves
- ✓ **Cut garden prunings** into small pieces and bag
- ✓ Make sure your bin is **not overflowing** and that there is no rubbish on or beside it
- ✓ Make sure your bin is **not jammed with rubbish**, so it can be completely emptied
- ✓ Contact Council to report any **cracks or damage** to bins



What not to put in your bin:

- ✗ Rocks, soil or palm fronds
- ✗ Liquids, paint, motor oil or car batteries
- ✗ Toxic or corrosive substances
- ✗ Electrical appliances
- ✗ Building materials, bricks, metal, tiles, timber off-cuts
